RE: European Union's REACH Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) Candidate List

In June 2007, the European Union (EU) Regulation 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) was entered into force. The regulation establishes specific duties and obligations on companies in the EU that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations, or in articles.

Under the structure of the REACH regulation, Voyager Electronics Corporation (VEC) is a distributor and supplier of "ARTICLES" to our EU customers. We do not manufacture "substances" or "preparations" and our articles do not involve the "intentional release of substances". Accordingly, we foresee no registration or pre-registration or requirement for the products we supply.

To our knowledge, our products (articles) do not contain any of the substances listed on the European Union's REACH Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) candidate list, dated 25 June 2020, in excess of a concentration of 0.1% weight/weight.
